JERUSALEM, FORTRESS CITY OF GOD

"As he drew near and came in sight of Jerusalem he shed tears over it and said: If you in your turn had only understood on this day the message of peace!" Lc 19,41.

The Holy Spirit makes us turn our gaze to Jerusalem. The history of the mankind does not depend on New York, or UN, or Brussels but it has depended on Jerusalem and will continue to depend on Israel or Jerusalem particularly because it is *"the deep heart of the North"* Ps48, or the *"pole of the world"*.: indivisible capital of the Son of God, *" true God true Man"* and then capital of everyone born again through the Holy Spirit as written the psalm 87: *"But all call Zion "Mother" since all were born here"*.

Let our hearts look forward to Jesus Christ, King of Israel, King of Jerusalem, whose Melkisedek was the prefiguration: Jesus, Messiah of Israel.

Without a vision given by the Holy Spirit on current events we cannot understand the meaning of these, and we are living as if we are blind. The Holy Spirit opens our mind and makes us able to apprehend God's project for the pagan nations. The great-men of this world and the nations who have apostatised God want the destruction of Israel and its division, while forgetting Judea and Samaria are called *"the mountain of the Lord"* in the plan of God, with Jerusalem as the capital. These great-men could destroy the temples, the ramparts, but Jerusalem will remain *"the pole of the world"*. God will not allow that the nation of Israel be destroyed as nation. From the coming of Jesus, who is the root of this vineyard, chosen and blessed by God, the vineyard is indestructible. Even *"wild animals eat it"* Ps79,14, of it God is the master and the Father, Jn15, 1: *"I am the true vine and my Father is the vinedresser"*. Israel cannot claim for itself its victories, because only God through his justice allows Israel to go into the Holy Land (Dt8, 5-6).

"But do not be afraid, my servant Jacob...look, I will rescue you from distant countries...for I am with you I will make an end of all the nations where I have scattered you; I will not make an end of you, only discipline you in moderation, so as not to let you go entirely unpunished" Jr.46,27-28.

From the election of this people, history is teaching us that through its persecutions Israel was always restored from a small, faithful remnant that was living in the depths of oblivion and despair. *"Jerusalem, Holy City, God scourged you for your handiwork. Thank the Lord as deserves and bless the King of the ages"* Ct.Tb.13, 10-11.

"Since from Zion the Law will go out, and the Word of God from Jerusalem" Mic4,...2. If Zion has received the Law to reveal the existence of sin, it is through *the Word gone out from Jerusalem* (Jesus), so that every man, from Adam to the last one to come, is saved, by grace, by a gift from God. In fact Jesus had been crucified outside of the ramparts of Jerusalem at Golgotha, *"The Word will go out from Jerusalem"* so that nothing is hidden and every man sees obviously this is the only One who is able to save. Ezekiel prophesied so: *"My people, I lead you back to the soil of Israel...And I shall put my spirit in you, and you will live, and I shall resettle you on your own soil; and you will know that I, God have said and done this."* Ez.37,12-14.

Then our Jewish brothers will recognize their Jewish Messiah, washed and purified from their sins, and will receive a new heart and new Spirit: *"When that day comes, I shall set myself to destroy all the nations who advance against Jerusalem...they will look on the one whom they have pierced, they will mourn for him as for an only son, and weep for him as people weep for a first-born child"* Zac.12, 9-10.

Facing the Wisdom of God and the folly of the apostate nations God rises up in his Light in the midst of the darkness. We have this duty in praising Israel so that the veil of the temple of everybody's heart tears to recognize Yeshoua, their Messiah. We Christians admit that Jesus was Jewish and He is come for the lost sheep of his people; we need to go back to the true Yeshoua of Gospel and to give Him back to those to whom He belongs since for ever. As the widow said: *"For I look to the Eternal for your rescue, and joy has come to me from the Holy One at the mercy soon to reach you, from your saviour, the Eternal"* Bar 4, 22.
